

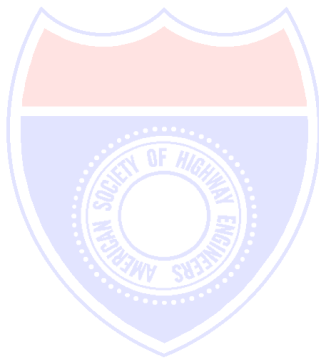
**Crain Ave. Project in Kent
Technical Presentation plus Tour of Project Site**

Thursday, August 26, 2010

Program:

Please join the Cuyahoga Valley Section of ASHE for a technical program outlining the design and construction challenges involved with the Crain Ave project in the City of Kent. This is a \$17.3 Million project designed to improve several intersections within the City and is highlighted by the replacement and relocation of the Crain Ave bridge which spans over a railroad and the Cuyahoga River. Mr. Jim Bowling, P.E., City of Kent Engineer, and Ms. Shelly Kendrick, P.E., with the project design firm ARCADIS, will give an overview of the project following lunch at the Pufferbelly. After the technical presentation we'll take a short walk to the construction site where representatives from Beaver Excavating will discuss the construction side of the project.
